

Re: Working in Labs with COVID19 related research

In light of the guidelines issued by the Council for Higher Education's Planning and Budgeting Committee (PBC), it is possible to continue carrying out research activities **in the COVID19 (corona) research laboratories only**. This refers to laboratories in which research is conducted that is directly related to the virus and the fight against the pandemic. Faculty members in charge of these laboratories will send lists of people to be allowed entrance to the campus which will include names of graduate students, to the Executive Vice President for Research.

Wherever possible, it is recommended to work from home. **In any case, it is not allowed to force students to come to campus. All safety rules and guidelines must be strictly observed.** In case of disagreement between the student and the advisor, please contact me directly.
