



Waiver+

For Whom?

- For those who were on reserve duty until 17.12.2023
- For those on reserve duty during the exams period
- For students who are parents and whose spouse was on reserve duty, *Atouda*, *Keva*, or mandatory service.

There are two groups:

Those were on reserve service for at least 10 consecutive days or at least 14 days combined during the exam period (7.12.23-5.1.24)*

Those who started their reserve service on 7.10 and until the beginning of the exam period (17.12) and who served at least 30 days*

Accommodations

What is "Waiver+"?

It means an exemption from a course. The credits will be counted toward the transcript as part of the degree requirement. The "Waiver+" is instead of *Moed B*. If you choose to take *Moed B*, you will not be able to ask for a "Waiver+".

*Also eligible for the following conditions:

Anyone who served in the reserves under emergency circumstances, in a special situation or on short notice of at least 5 consecutive days during the exam period. (7.12.2023-5.1.2024)

Those who served in the reserves on the day of the exam are entitled not to take the exam and to receive an alternative solution, such as a reserve exam.
